Expenses/Disbursements

Expenses associated with your case, known as disbursements, must be paid to external parties. These fees are independent of our firm in support of your application. These charges are separate from the fixed fees mentioned earlier. You may incur some of the following disbursements:

- Priority service fees
- Visa application fees,
- Immigration health surcharge fees
- Tribunal/Court fees
- Home Office fees
- Biometric enrolment fees
- Expert reports
- Interpreters' fees
- Translation cost
- Mileage and parking

Fee Waiver Applications

If you are unable to afford your fees, you can submit a fee waiver application to request a waiver. If your application is approved, you will not be required to pay any application fees or related costs. However, please be aware that this waiver does not cover our fees and disbursements or any fees charged by third parties. The fee waiver application is reserved for some immigration applications. Application Processing Time

Submitting your application to the Home Office will take between 1 to 4 weeks. This will depend on how promptly you provide the requested document in support of your application.

Once you submit your application, the decision-making timelines are determined by the Home Office, and we cannot influence them. While we cannot guarantee a specific timeframe, we can refer you to the Home Office guidance on the processing times for your application. Each application type varies and has different processing timeframes. Factors that may affect processing time include the complexity and type of the application, as well as the current demand for such applications.

Crime Legal Fees and Costs

We believe it is essential that you understand exactly what you are paying for from the outset. We are transparent about our pricing to ensure there are no surprises.

Below are our fees for private clients. Please note that all prices are quoted exclusive of VAT (where applicable) and do not include any additional expenses, such as third-party costs, mileage, parking and other disbursements.

Motoring Offence Fees

We are required to publish pricing details for certain motoring offences, including summary-only offences. These cases are dealt with in the Magistrates' Court and do not proceed to the Crown Court.

In many cases, we can offer a fixed fee for our services. However, not every case is straightforward. If a matter is complex or if the evidence is likely to change, a fixed fee may not be appropriate.

For cases suitable for a fixed-fee arrangement, the fees are outlined below.

Guilty pleas - First appearance and sentencing:

London and the surrounding areas	£750 for your first hearing.
Driving offence – Guilty pleas	£350 for each additional hearing
Fees do not include instructing experts	

Outside London	£360 for your first hearing.
Driving offence – Guilty pleas	£250 for each additional hearing, usually a single additional hearing after the trial hearing if the court adjourns for sentencing.

Not guilty pleas - First appearance and listing case for trial:

London and the surrounding areas	£1,750
Driving offence – Not guilty pleas	This fee covers your first appearance and any subsequent trial hearing.

This fee does not include the cost of lodging or conducting an appeal.	£500 If the trial hearing lasts more than a day, this is the cost per hearing on each additional day.

More complex motoring matters typically take about 10 to 15 hours of work, especially when court representation is necessary. Our hourly rate is for summary-only motoring offences.

- Taking detailed instructions and preparing witness statements
- Reviewing the evidence against you
- Advising you on your plea and the likely outcome

- Assessing whether there are grounds to argue exceptional hardship or special reasons
- Representing you at one court hearing
